

Fusidic acid (Fusidic acid sodium salt)

Your patch tests indicate you have a contact allergy to Fusidic acid

This means that you should avoid all products containing Fusidic acid. Fusidic acid is an antibiotic which is found in some prescribed creams, ointments and eye drops. Typically these products may be prescribed for infected eczema or impetigo.

Fusidic acid is found in the following products:

Fucidin H cream
Fucibet cream
Fucibet Lipid cream
Fucidin cream
Fucidin ointment
Fucithalmic eye drops

Much more rarely, Fusidic acid may be given as a tablet or an intravenous infusion ('drip'), so make sure that any hospital doctor knows about your allergy, as well as your GP.
