



Cocamide DEA

You are allergic to cocamide DEA. This means that you should avoid all products containing cocamide DEA in the future. It is also known as coconut diethanolamide, cocamine diethanolamine and coconut fatty acids diethanolamide.

Cocamide DEA is a surfactant (foaming agent) found in **some** of the following types of products:

- Shampoos and conditioners including Dandraxol antidandruff shampoos
- Antifungal and antiseptic creams
- Hand gels
- Liquid hand soaps and cleansers
- Industrial hand cleansers and barrier creams
- Hydraulic oils and metal working fluids

Occupations at risk of developing allergy to cocamide DEA include healthcare workers, metal workers and hairdressers
