

Caine Mix

Your patch tests show you have a contact allergy to Caine Mix. This means that you should avoid contact with products containing skin numbing creams (anaesthetics) in the future. The Caine Mix you were tested to contains:

- Benzocaine
- Cinchocaine (Dibucaine)
- Amethocaine (Tetracaine)

You may be allergic to one or more of these. Products with the local anaesthetics you are allergic to include:
