



Econazole

Your patch tests indicate that you have a contact allergy to econazole. This means that you should avoid contact with this substance in the future.

Econazole is an anti-fungal found in creams and vaginal pessaries most commonly used to treat Candida (thrush) infections.

Econazole is closely related to other antifungals in the same imidazole group. Rarely, the other imidazole antifungals, clotrimazole and miconazole, may cause your skin to react too.

Econazole is found in the following products:

- Econazole cream
- Pevaryl 1% topical cream
- Gyno-Pevaryl vaginal pessaries
- Gyno-Pevaryl Once Pessary
